

Dear Chapter representatives,

I have had no discussions concerning the Recall petitions with Mr. Brockbank. I had one conversation with Mr. Brockbank in which I verified his email so I could send him a copy of the Open letter with the signators. This is the complete extent of my interaction with Mr. Brockbank over the past 2 months.

The only issue I brought up for discussion, via e-mail to the President and Board, with Brockbank was the public release of the names of the petitioners.

Furthermore, the question asked of Mr. Brockbank in this opinion was to the merits of the removal of Chris Kirschner by the Board on a 4-3 vote.
