This is a contract between an AGA Chapter and the AGA, for the purpose of providing equipment to Chapters to help them provide sets for Chapter activities. By signing below, you affirm the information given above and agree to the terms specified here.

I am authorized to act for the AGA Chapter named above. I understand that the equipment we have requested is owned by the AGA, and that the chapter agrees to provide this equipment back to the AGA on request should the need arise, at AGA expense.

This equipment is to be retained by the chapter for the purpose of aiding it in running tournaments and/or educational activities, and to promote play within the Chapter. It may not be sold or given away without the written permission of the AGA.
